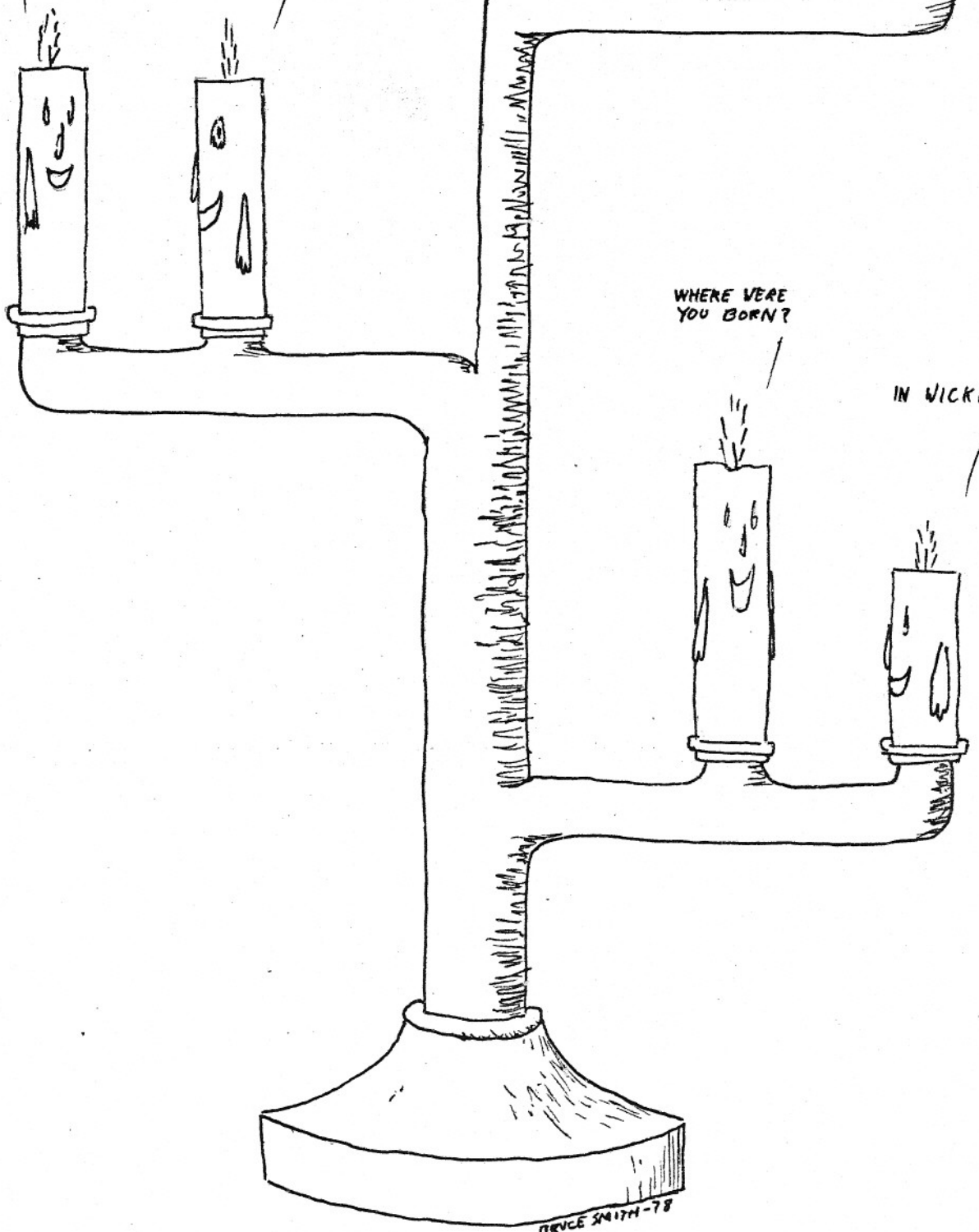

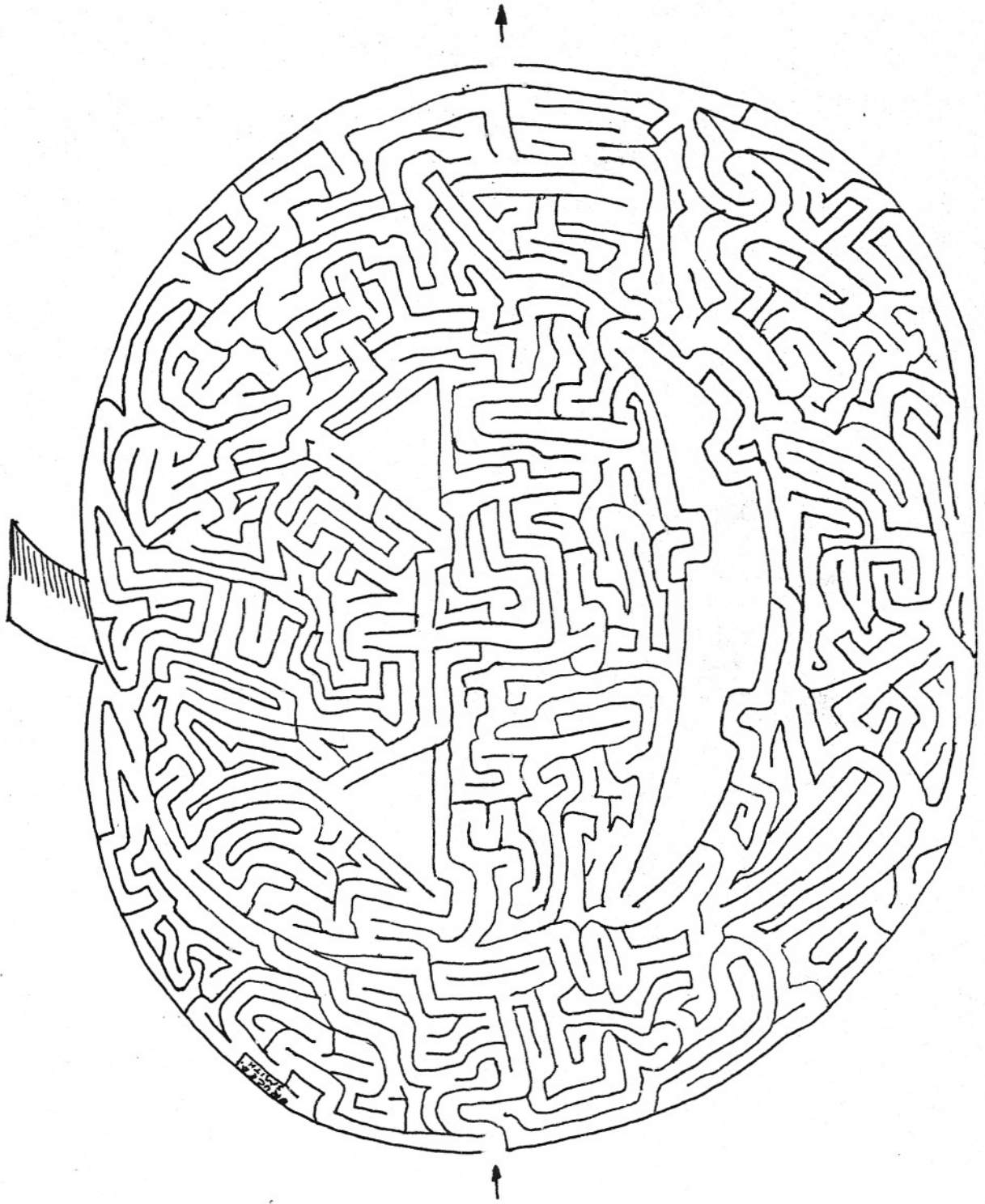

HALLOWEEN MAZE



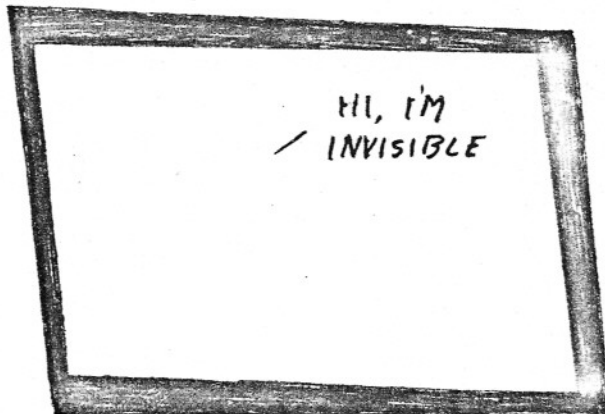
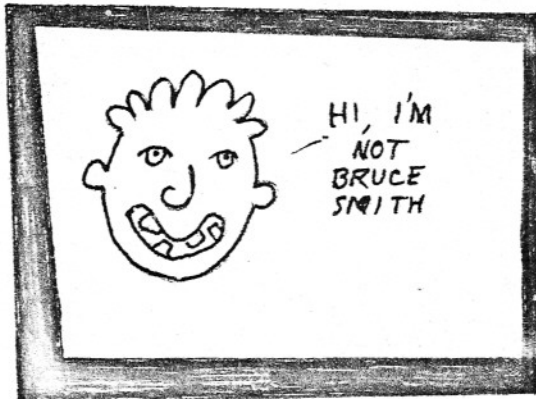
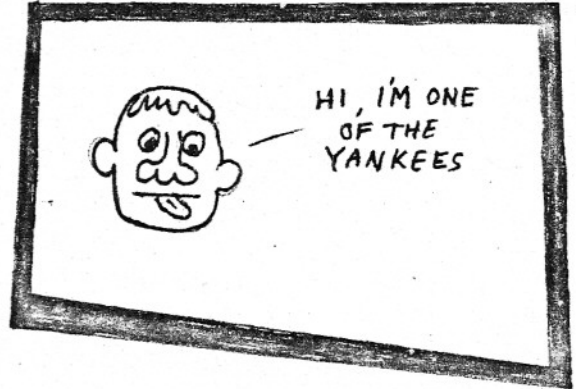
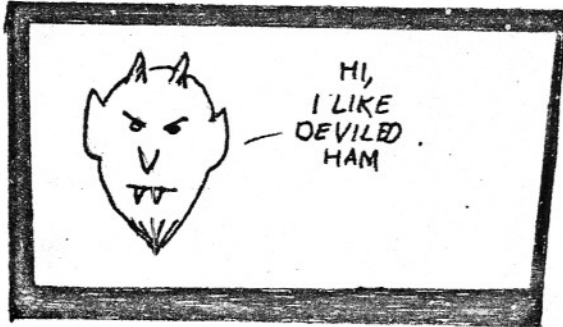
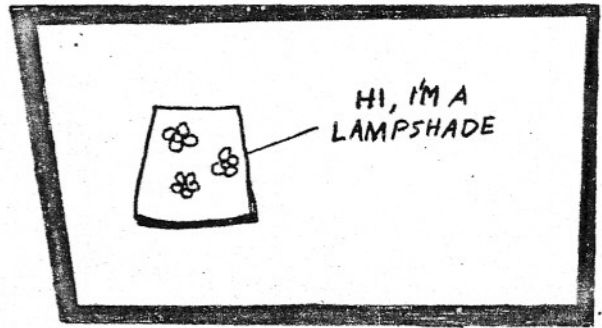
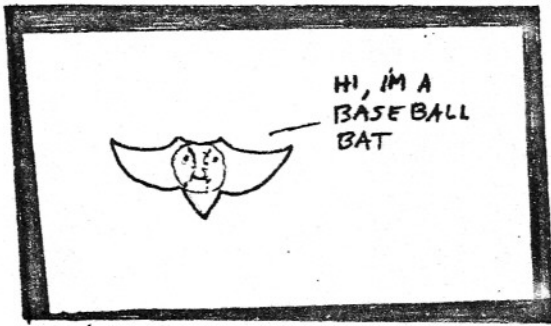
